

1 Step # 1:

Print the decoration pages on your printer. Be sure to have a grownup help switch the paper or toner if your printer requires special materials for color printing.

2. Step # 2:

WARNING: DO NOT USE SCISSORS WITHOUT ADULT SUPERVISON. Find an adult to help you.

Cut around the edges of Headers, Frames, Bubbles, Corners, and Friends.

Step # 3:

Use paste or another adhesive to attach your cutouts to your scrapbook pages.


TIPS:

- Use "Headers" to announce the theme of the page. They don't always have to be at the top.
- Frames come in two sizes. The smaller ones are for wallet-sized photos. Trim
 out the inside of the frame and lay it over your favorite photos.
- Place "Bubbles" near Lilo, Stitch, or the people in your photos. We've given you
 a couple blank bubbles that you can fill in yourself. What do you want to say?
- Stick "Corners" in the four corners of the page. They help create a theme.
- Cut out your "Friends" Lilo and Stitch to help decorate each page.
- Don't worry if you make a mistake when you're cutting. You can always make another printout and try again.
- If you don't have a store-bought album to decorate, you can make your own scrapbook with blank sheets of paper. Decorate the pages then bind them together with staples, tape, or yarn. Be creative!




































































